

Student Code of Conduct and Student Conduct Review Procedures

Student Code of Conduct

As with all members of the university community, the University requires students to conduct themselves honestly and responsibly and to respect the rights of others. Students may not engage in behavior that disrupts the learning environment, violates the rights of others or otherwise violates the Student Code of Conduct (Code), university rules, regulations, or procedures. Students and student organizations will be responsible for ensuring that they and their guests comply with the Code while on property owned or controlled by the University or at activities authorized or sponsored by the University. Student Conduct Review Procedures

A student conduct procedure is a review undertaken by the University to establish whether there is substantial information to determine if it is more likely than not that a student violated the Code.
