

# Occupational Endorsement Certificate in Guardianship

The Occupational Endorsement Certificate (OEC) in Guardianship prepares students for careers as public guardians in Alaska. The certificate is designed to provide students with an understanding of the social, legal, and policy context of guardianship and its variations in Alaska. The OEC in Guardianship emphasizes engaging in effective and ethical management of guardianship cases, ensuring accountability, sensitivity to complex needs, and cultural responsiveness.
